Land Trusts are local, grass-roots, non-profit conservation organizations directly involved in protecting natural, scenic, recreational, agricultural, historic, or cultural lands.



■ Land Trusts:

- Preserve land through donations, life estates, and purchases;
- Secure and monitor conservation easements;
- Work in partnership with private and governmental conservation agencies.



The WLCT is a private, nonprofit organization founded in 1987 to protect open space in Warren and keep that land undeveloped forever.

The WLCT preserves and restores land for the benefit of the general public and the conservation of Warren's natural resources, including:

- Wetlands
- Woodlands
- Farmlands
- Plant and animal habitats
- Unique natural and scenic sites

The WLCT is under the stewardship of volunteer Warren residents.


Land that is acquired by the WLCT is not owned by the Town government, it is held by the Trust for all to enjoy.



'Dicimus pro aboribus'

The Trust's motto, *Dicamus Pro Abores*, means "We Speak for the Trees".

The WLCT also works to preserve and protect Warren's entire natural environment for future generations.



■ Trust Lands

The Warren Land Conservation Trust now owns thirty parcels, over 80 acres. Most of this beautiful land has been generously donated by local residents.

The largest parcel, and currently the Trust's crown jewel, is the 47-acre salt marsh at Jacobs Point along the East Bay Bike Path on the Warren River.

Two major projects, the salt marsh restoration at Jacobs Point and along the Palmer River, were the result of collaborating with Save the Bay and DEM. Such collaborations are vital to achieve the goals of the WLCT.
