The WLCT is a private, non-profit organization founded in 1987 to preserve open places in Warren and keep that land protected FOREVER.


We are self governing and independent from town government. Land that we acquire is held in trust for the benefit of our community to enjoy!

We have completed a major restoration of the salt marsh at Jacob's Point. More significant work to remove invasive species at Jacob's Point and the Haile Farm Preserve is planned in partnership with Save the Bay, RIDEM and the Natural Resources Conservation Service (USDA).

These partnerships and collaborations along with a strong community support are vital to continuing the Warren Land Conservation Trust's mission of conserving, caring for, maintaining and providing access to these open spaces for everyone to enjoy.
